We will be able to see and hear each other and your lesson notes/materials will be emailed to you before your session begins. If we venture into any new areas during the lesson, I will email you the materials there and then, or as soon as possible after the session ends.

BOOKING:

- Arrange your lesson with me by phone or email.
- Once the lesson has been arranged, I will send you a PayPal payment request.
- You must pay for your lesson at least 48 hours in advance otherwise it will be cancelled.
- Lesson fees are non-refundable.

HOW IT WORKS:

- I will call you via Skype at your designated lesson time – please make sure that you are logged in!
- If you have something in particular that you would like to work on, please let me know in advance of your lesson so that I can prepare any PDFs I may need to email to you.
- During the lesson we will be able to see and hear each other. If possible, please test your video and sound in advance of your lesson and find a position where I will be able to see both of your hands on-screen at the same time.

YOU WILL NEED:

- A working internet connection.
- A webcam with sound (we need to be able to see and hear each other).
- Your ukulele – please tune it in advance if possible.
- A computer, tablet, smartphone or similar device with the latest version of Skype installed (Skype is free to use)
- The ability to open PDF files. Adobe Reader is free to download and use.

SAFEGUARDING:

- Stuart has an Enhanced DBS check.
- References can be supplied on-request.
- Stuart's Skype account will be used for lessons only and not for sharing photos or general messaging.
- If the student is a child, a parent/guardian/carer should be there for the very start of the lesson and thereafter, nearby. If a parent wishes to be in the room for the entire lesson, this is ok too.
- Students should be dressed as if they were attending a face-to-face lesson.
- Lessons will not be recorded because of the risk of personal data being held indefinitely.
